Non-NHS Medical Reports/Forms/Examinations Fee List (2020-21)

Please read the Frequent Asked Questions Leaflet on non-NHS work. The Leaflet is available on the website and at Reception.

Forms: There is a charge for the completion of all non-NHS forms. Bring the forms to show the receptionists. Payment must be made when handing in the form at Reception. Please allow at least 2 weeks (ten working days) for complete of any reports or forms.

Insurance Medicals and other Medicals: All non-NHS medical examinations are conducted outside normally bookable appointments. So please speak to the Receptionist who will arrange an appointment which will be at a time suggested by the doctor concerned. The current fees are displayed at Reception or on the website.

The practice accepts payments in cash or cheques. Cheques can only be accepted if accompanied by a current cheque guarantee card.

Private Referrals: Our practice procedure for processing private referrals is different from NHS referrals. A referral letter will be ready for collection no sooner than 5 working days after seeing your doctor, unless medically urgent, which will be made clear to you during your consultation.

Please do not make an appointment to see a consultant until after you have collected your referral letter, unless your doctor has arranged differently with you.

There is no charge for any referral letter but a fee is payable if you wish your GP to complete any private health insurance claim form.

Your GP will only complete a private insurance claim form if you have been referred by him/her before you see a consultant.

There are certain forms/reports the practice GPs do not do. They are listed.

The BMA suggests fees that GPs may charge their patients for non-NHS work (i.e. work not covered under their contract with the NHS) in order to help GPs set their own professional fees. However, the fees suggested by the BMA are intended for guidance only; they are not recommendations and a doctor is not obliged to charge the rates the BMA suggests. Where possible, we base our fees suggested by the BMA guidance.
